



Consignment Policy

The Mac Rack is a family owned and operated business. Our goal is to sell quality items at a price that is a value for both the buyer and seller. We accept in season quality clothing free of stains, rips or repairs, Home Décor, Furniture, Sporting Goods and Jewelry. We do not accept appliances, electronics, tools, books, musical instruments, knock off designer products, damaged furniture or clothing. Please inspect all items carefully before bringing them in. All furniture requires picture photos before consigning with The Mac Rack.

ALL consignments are accepted by appointment only. This allows us to review each item one-on-one and agree on a selling price. Each consignment appointment is limited to 25 items (excluding jewelry or accessories). Our consignment proceeds are shared as follows:

- 40% to Consignor for individual items sold less than \$50.00
- 60% to Consignor for individual items sold greater than \$50.00

Every month a consignor's proceeds totaling \$25.00 or more, a check will be mailed along with an itemized list of the selling price of the items. Checks will be mailed no later than the 15th of the following month after the proceeds are earned. Proceeds under \$25.00 will be held over to the following month or until the consignment term is over and at that time a check will be mailed. Consignment proceeds also can be held at The Mac Rack and used as in-store credit.

All consigned items may be subject to sales and discounts as The Mac Rack feels appropriate.

If any consigned items remain unsold after 90 days, they can be picked up by appointment. The Mac Rack will allow consignors to gather their items after 90 days and prior to 100 days. Any items remaining after 100 days will be donated to the Charity of our choice.

The Mac Rack is not responsible for loss due to theft, fire or any natural disaster.
